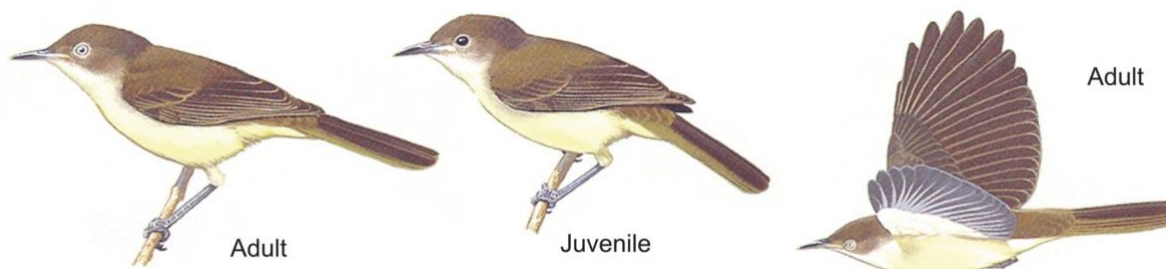


Green-backed Honeyeater *Glycichaera fallax* Species No.: 604 Band size: 01 (02) AY



Morphometrics:

Four subspecies recognised, but only *G.f. claudi* occurs in Australia on central eastern Cape York, Qld with measurements as follows:

	Adult Male	Adult Female
Wing:	62 – 65 mm	58 – 61 mm
Tail:	44 – 49 mm	42 – 48 mm
Bill:	14.2 – 16.7 mm	14.1 – 16.1 mm
Tarsus:	18.1 – 18.8 mm	16.8 – 19.2 mm
Weight:	7.5 – 11.5 g	8 – 10.5 g

Ageing:

	Adult (1+)	Juvenile
Bill:	mostly brownish grey-black with pale pink-buff tip and light grey basal half;	as adult;
Gape:	pink-buff;	yellow;
Iris:	light blue-grey or cream;	dark;

No information available on ageing, so age all adults as (1+).

Sexing:

Males are larger than females, but there are no plumage differences; No information as to roles of sexes in incubation.
