### AMAZÔNIA NATIONAL PARK - EXTENSION

5 DAYS



*Welcome to Amazônia National Park tour. The Amazônia National Park is located between the Tapajós and Madeira Rivers, intersected by the famous Transamazônica Road, covers an area of more than 900,000 ha, including three municipalities Itaituba, Maués and Aveiro. It is a great place to find several endemic species of the Amazon birds. During dawn at certain times of the year, it is possible to be dazzled by large flocks of Parrots along the road. Most of the habitat of the National Park is made up of Terra Firme forest, where there are ecological trails that are used for birdwatching. Also the view of the sunset of Tapajós riverbank with its clear waters is one of the most beautiful of the Amazon region.*

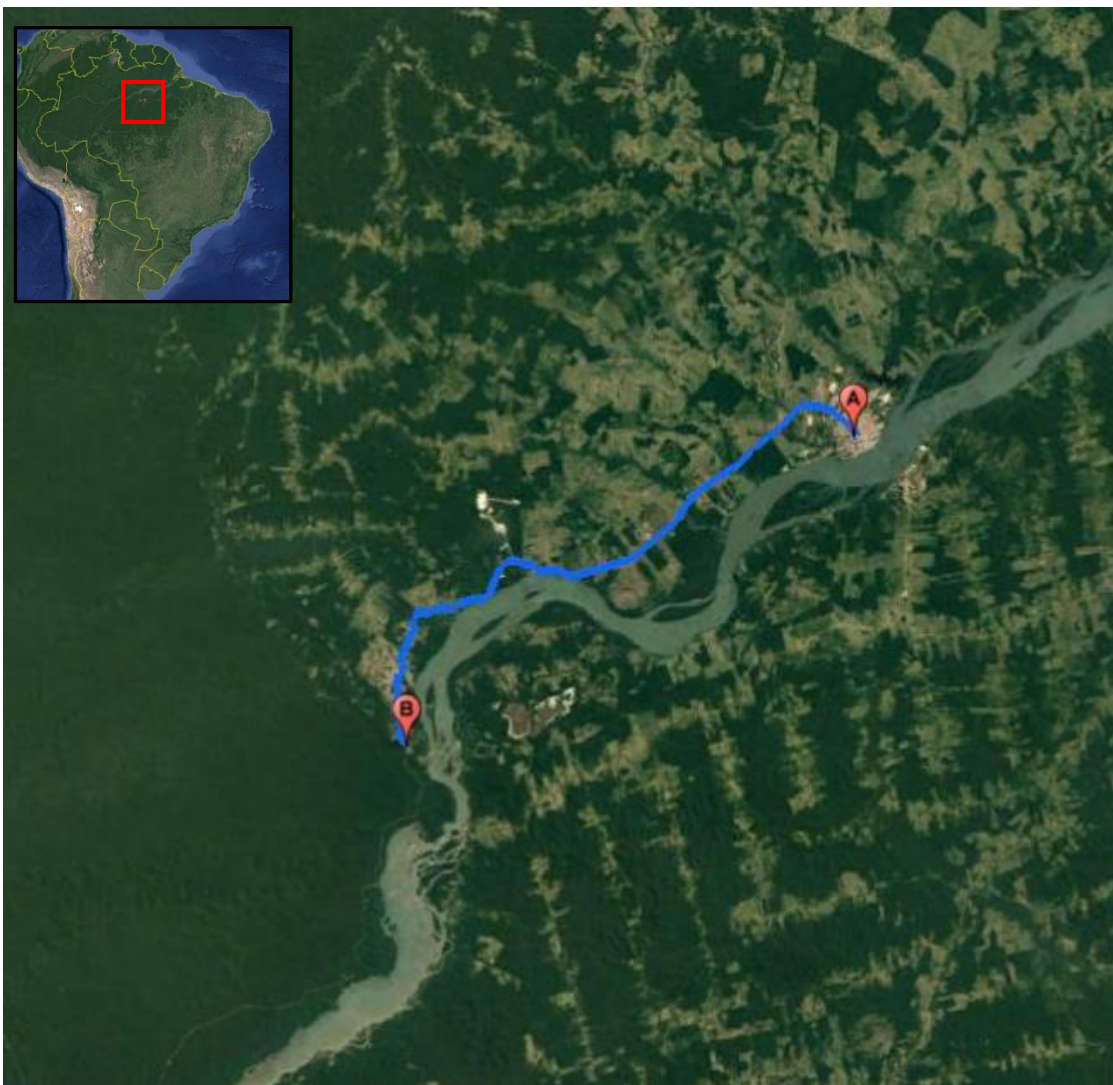

## OVERVIEW OF THE COMPLETE ITINERARY

## DETAILED ITINERARY

**Day 1:** Arrival in **Itaituba** and transfer to the Pousada near the **AMAZÔNIA NATIONAL PARK** (50km).

**Area description:** There are several trails inside the National Park with different lengths, we will access at least 4 of them, where the canopy of more than 40 meters reigns, in these places there are small streams (Igarapés), where it is also possible to find species linked to this type of environment. In addition, the Transamazônica is a great place to observe birds that are feeding in the trees with fruits in the margins of the road.



**Day 2:** Full Day Birding in **Amazônia National Park**.

Birding all day on the Amazon National Park trails. Some of the target species are: **Golden Parakeet** (*Guaruba guarouba*), **White-crested Guan** (*Penelope pileata*) **Cryptic Forest-Falcon** (*Micrastur mintoni*), **Blue-cheeked Jacamar** (*Galbula cyanicollis*), **Hoffmanns's Woodcreeper** (*Dendrocolaptes hoffmannsi*), **Razor-billed Curassow** (*Mitu tuberosum*), **Brown-chested Barbet** (*Capito brunneipectus*), **Gould's Toucanet** (*Selenidera gouldii*), **Alta Floresta Antpitta** (*Hylopezus whittakeri*), **Musician Wren** (*Cyphorhinus arada*).





**Day 3: Full Day Birding in Amazônia National Park.**

AM birding along the famous Capelinha trail, where mixed flocks and ants swarm antbirds can be found, also Parrots. The targets species are: Broad-billed Motmot (*Electron platyrhynchum*), **Harlequin Antbird (*Rhegmatorhina berlepschi*)**, Wing-banded Antbird (*Myrmornis torquata*), Pale-faced Bare-eye (*Phlegopsis borbae*), Black-spotted Bare-eye (*Phlegopsis nigromaculata*), Spix's Warbling-Antbird (*Hypocnemis striata*), Ihering's Antwren (*Myrmotherula inhering*), **Snow-capped Manakin (*Lepidothrix nattereri*)**, Santarem Parakeet (*Pyrrhura amazonum*), Kawall's Parrot (*Amazona kawalli*).

PM birding in Tapajós River.

**Area description:** The Tapajos River forms several islands in its courses, some of them are near where we will stay. These islands contain several species, one of them in particular, **Blackish-grey Antshrike (*Thamnophilus nigrocinereus huberi*)**, a differentiated population that will be separated soon. Other target species are: Band-tailed Nighthawk (*Nyctiprogne leucopyga*), Amazonian Inezia (*Inezia subflava*), Amazonian Streaked Antwren (*Myrmotherula multostriata*).





**Day 4: Full Day Birding in Amazônia National Park.**

AM birding at the Park's headquarters and on nearby trails. Among the species that we will look for are Natterer's Slaty-Antshrike (*Thamnophilus stictocephalus*) Flame-crowned Manakin (*Heterocercus lineatus*), **Black-bellied Gnatcatcher (*Conopophaga melanogaster*)**, **Vulturine Parrot (*Pyrilia vulturina*)**, Dark-winged Trumpeter (*Psophia viridis*), Collared Puffbird (*Bucco capensis*).



The afternoon searches for missing species.

**Day 5:** Depending on the flight schedule, we can birding in the morning looking for missing species.

Transfer to the **Itaituba**.
